Qualities of Righteous :-

i) Humility :-

(Surah Targhan - (63-77))

→ The true servants of the most compassionate are those who walk on the earth humbly, and when the foolish address them improperly, they only respond with peace.

ii) Sincere Devotion :-

They are those who spend a good portion of the night, prostrating themselves and standing before their Lord.

iii) Hope and Fear :-

They are those who pray to our Lord! Keep the punishment of Hell away from us, for its punishment is indeed unrelenting. It is certainly an excellent place to settle and reside.

(iv) Moderate Spending :-

→ They are those who spend neither wastefully nor stingily, but moderate in between.

(v) Avoiding Major Sins :-

→ They are those who do not invoke any other god besides God, nor take a human life made sacred by God - except with legal rights - nor commit fornication. And whoever does face the penalty.

"I admonish you against laughing a lot, since that would cause the heart to perish and the light of your face to fade."
